Joy of Salvation - testing of our faith

### 2 Corinthians 4:17-18

For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison, <sup>18</sup>while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

## Romans 1:10, 11 –

For if while we were enemies, we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. <sup>11</sup>And not only this, but we also exult in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.

# Philippians 1:21-26 -

For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain. <sup>22</sup>But if I am to live on in the flesh, this will mean fruitful labor for me; and I do not know which to choose. <sup>23</sup>But I am hard-pressed from both directions, having the desire to depart and be with Christ, for that is very much better; <sup>24</sup>yet to remain on in the flesh is more necessary for your sake. <sup>25</sup>And convinced of this, I know that I shall remain and continue with you all for your progress and joy in the

faith, <sup>26</sup>so that your proud confidence in me may abound in Christ Jesus through my coming to you again.

#### Acts 13:50-52 -

But the Jews aroused the devout women of prominence and the leading men of the city, and instigated a persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and drove them out of their district. <sup>51</sup>But they shook off the dust of their feet in protest against them and went to Iconium. <sup>52</sup>And the disciples were continually filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.

#### Jude 24 -

Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to make you stand in the presence of His glory blameless with great joy,

Hebrews 13:17-18. Obey your leaders and submit *to them*, for they keep watch over your souls as those who will give an account Let them do this with joy and not <sup>l</sup>with grief, for this would be unprofitable for you. <sup>18</sup> Pray for us, for we are sure that we have a good conscience, desiring to conduct ourselves honorably in all things.

Matthew 5:11-12. "Blessed are you when *people* insult you and persecute you, and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of Me. <sup>12</sup> Rejoice and be glad, for your reward in heaven is great; for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were
